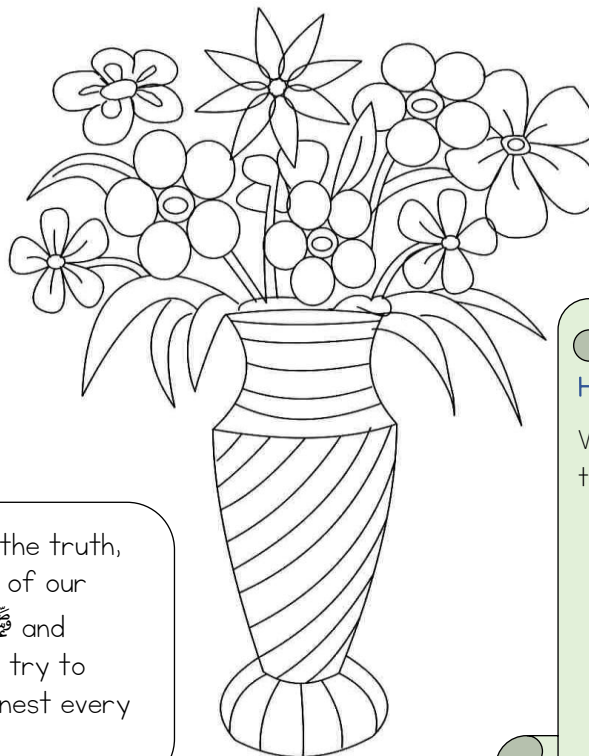
STORY TIME – THE HONEST BOY
