A special Hadith

(Bukhari)

This hadith teaches us that being **the best** Muslim is not just about praying or reading the Quran, but also about how we treat others.

Having **good manners** means being polite, kind, and respectful to everyone around us. **Good character** means being honest, helpful, and forgiving.
